We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2017-18 educational progress for the Hartland Consolidated School District. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. Our staff is available to help you understand this information. Each school will also be communicating their own AER to parents directly. These reports contain the following information:

**Student Assessment Data** – Includes the following four assessments: M-STEP (Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress), MI-Access (Alternate Assessment), and College Board SAT (11<sup>th</sup> grade). The data presents assessment information for English language arts and mathematics for grades 3-11, as well as science and social studies for grades 5, 8 and 11. This data is compared to state averages for all students as well as subgroups of students. The report helps users to understand achievement performance within grades and schools, and to make comparisons to district, state, and national achievement benchmarks.

## Accountability – Detail Data and Status

The accountability portion of the AER includes assessment proficiency and participation rates, graduation or attendance rates, as well as accountability index values showing school performance on a 0-100 scale.

## **Teacher Qualification Data**

- Identifies teacher qualifications at district and school levels.
- Reports percentage of core academic classes taught by teachers not considered highly qualified to teach such classes.

## NAEP Data (National Assessment of Educational Progress)

• Provides state results of the national assessment in mathematics and reading every other year in grades 4 and 8
