April 3rd through May 18th

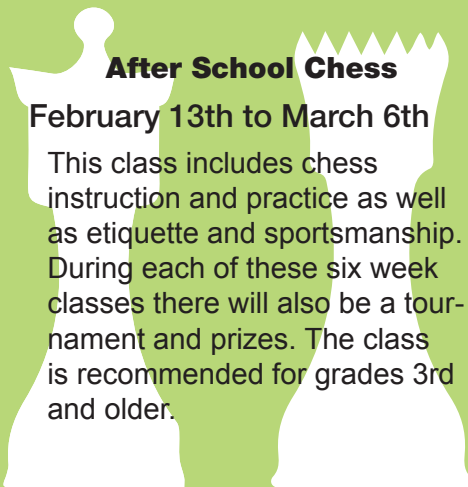

Saturdays, Feb. 3rd to 24th

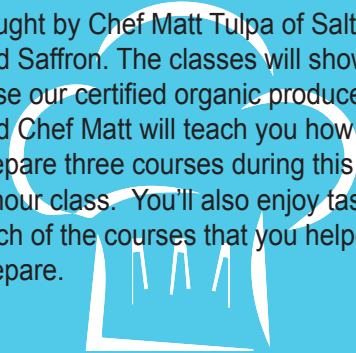

Excel III, Feb. 14th and 21st

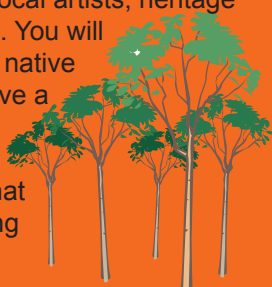
Picks up where Excel I left off. Covers versions 2007/10/13/16. Prepares you to be proficient with financial tasks done in the office as well as at home.
