

SCHOOLS OF CHOICE ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES HARTLAND CONSOLIDATED SCHOOLS

The Hartland Consolidated School District is accepting applications for enrollment for the 2020/2021 school year for students who do not reside within the district's boundaries pursuant to section 105 and 105c of the State Aid Act. There are unlimited openings in the Kindergarten program, grades 1 – 12, and Alternative Education.

- Transportation will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian; however, Hartland will consider providing transportation from an existing Hartland bus stop.
- Students are not charged tuition and they do not need a release from their home district if accepted for enrollment in Hartland Consolidated Schools under the Schools of Choice program.
- Applications may be obtained in person, by mail, by fax or online at **hartlandschools.us**
- ***Notification of acceptance will occur within two weeks of receipt of the application.***
