## Pinckney Community Schools:

School breakfast/lunch will be available every Tuesday and Thursday between 4 pm - 6 pm for any student/family who could benefit from receiving a school breakfast/lunch—in front of pathfinder school at the main office entry. Remain in vehicles as the food will be brought to each car. A two-day portion will be provided during each distribution. An electronic form is needed for those who are unable pick up the food so it can be delivered.

Mobile food pantry this Wednesday (3/18) between 5 pm - 6 pm at the district transportation/bus garage.

Farley hill food pantry: the food pantry will continue to be open every Thursday evening from 5 pm - 6:30 pm

## Howell Public Schools:

Monday, March 16, 23 and 30 from 4 to 6 pm the Food Service Department will be providing meal kits to any families who need them. The kits will contain both breakfast and lunch items for the week. Pick up will be in the circle driveway on the north side of Howell High School (near the rock). Delivery is available for those who cannot pick up a kit.

## Brighton Area Schools:

Brighton Area Schools Student Nutrition Department has donated a large quantity of unused food to Gleaners for distribution to BAS families during the shutdown. Gleaners' Shared Harvest Pantry will be open **by appointment only**. The pantry will be a drive up service with a box of food; and may include meat, fresh produce, toilet paper and laundry soap (as supplies are available. 517-548-3710)

BAS will also continue our "Blessings in a Backpack" program by distributing food in the BECC parking lot on the next three Tuesdays from 11:00am until 1:00pm. This will be a drive through pick up process.
