

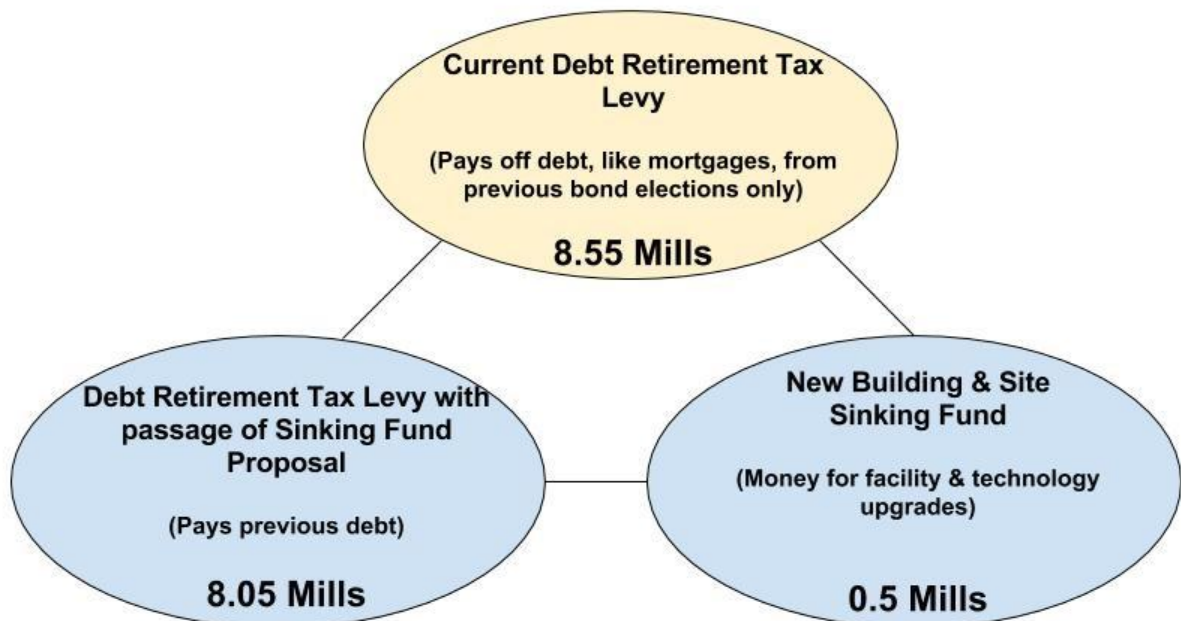
HCS Building & Site Sinking Fund May 2, 2017

Excerpt From The Ballot Language: *“Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Hartland Consolidated Schools, Livingston County, Michigan, **be increased** by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 0.50 mill...”*

If the Building & Site Sinking Fund proposal passes on May 2, 2017, in June 2017 the HCS Board of Education will lower the current Debt Retirement Tax Levy by 0.5 mills to make up the difference for the new 0.5 mills Sinking Fund resulting in a **net zero tax rate increase**.
