New Bus Driver Compensation Package Released

The district has revamped our bus driver compensation package to include medical benefit options. There is currently a \$2,000 signing bonus and a \$750 HCS or LESA employee referral bonus. The following package applies for 2022-23:

Hourly Pay = \$18.87 - \$21.22 per hour

Paid Training

Health Benefits = Single Person or the same amount applied toward Full-Family or 2-Person benefits **Life Insurance**

\$5.000 = Cash-in-lieu if health benefits are not taken or needed

\$2,000 = Signing Bonus

Extra Wages = Field Trip opportunities

Substitute Drivers Needed = 1 to 5 days a week and morning or afternoon, you determine availability.
