

# Military Recruitment Opt-Out Form

Complete this form to exercise your federal right to privacy for secondary students

If you **do not** want your or your child's personal information released to military recruiters, you must sign this form and return it to the school office by the end of August.

I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby exercise my federal right, granted to me by the Congress of the United States under section 9528 of the *Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965*, as amended by the *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001*, (and any other applicable state, federal or local law or any school policy), and hereby request that the name, address, and telephone listing of \_\_\_\_\_ (name of student), a current student at Hartland Consolidated Schools, **not** be released to military recruiters without prior written parental consent. I do, however, consent to the disclosure of such information to institutions of higher education other than military schools.
