This project was advertised on the state website and the local paper of record during the months of April 2021 and May 2021. A total of 47 bids were collected for the project. The project consists of the construction of the new Robotics Lab remodel and addition along with the boiler replacement located at the HESSC Building.

The Robotics project will begin this July/August and be substantially complete February/March 2022. The boiler replacement is scheduled to be completed this fall prior to heating season.

There are multiple alternates on this bid package which were separated from the base bid to be able to quantify the individual prices from the items at bid time. The listed alternates were reviewed and are being recommend by the administration. The recommended items are shown on the attached Budget Worksheet which also outlines the contractor's base bid values, the allocations to specific funding source (bond or sinking fund), the description of alternates, and the total awarded amounts.

The BP02 budget for this phase of Bond work (Robotics Lab) is \$1,018,227.00. The BP02 recommended awarded amount for this portion of work is \$1,685,318.00. The current "overage" of \$667,091.00 (\$1,685,318.00 - \$1,018,227.00) will be funded from the BP01 bid savings.

The BP02 total recommended award amount for Sinking Fund work (HESSC Boiler Replacement) is \$282,060.00. With the addition of \$5,641.00 for general conditions and \$19,744.00 for contingency, the total Sinking Fund project total is \$307,445.00. This amount had been accounted for and set aside, by HCS, in the current Sinking Fund Budget.
