## DISTRICT-WIDE IMPROVEMENTS

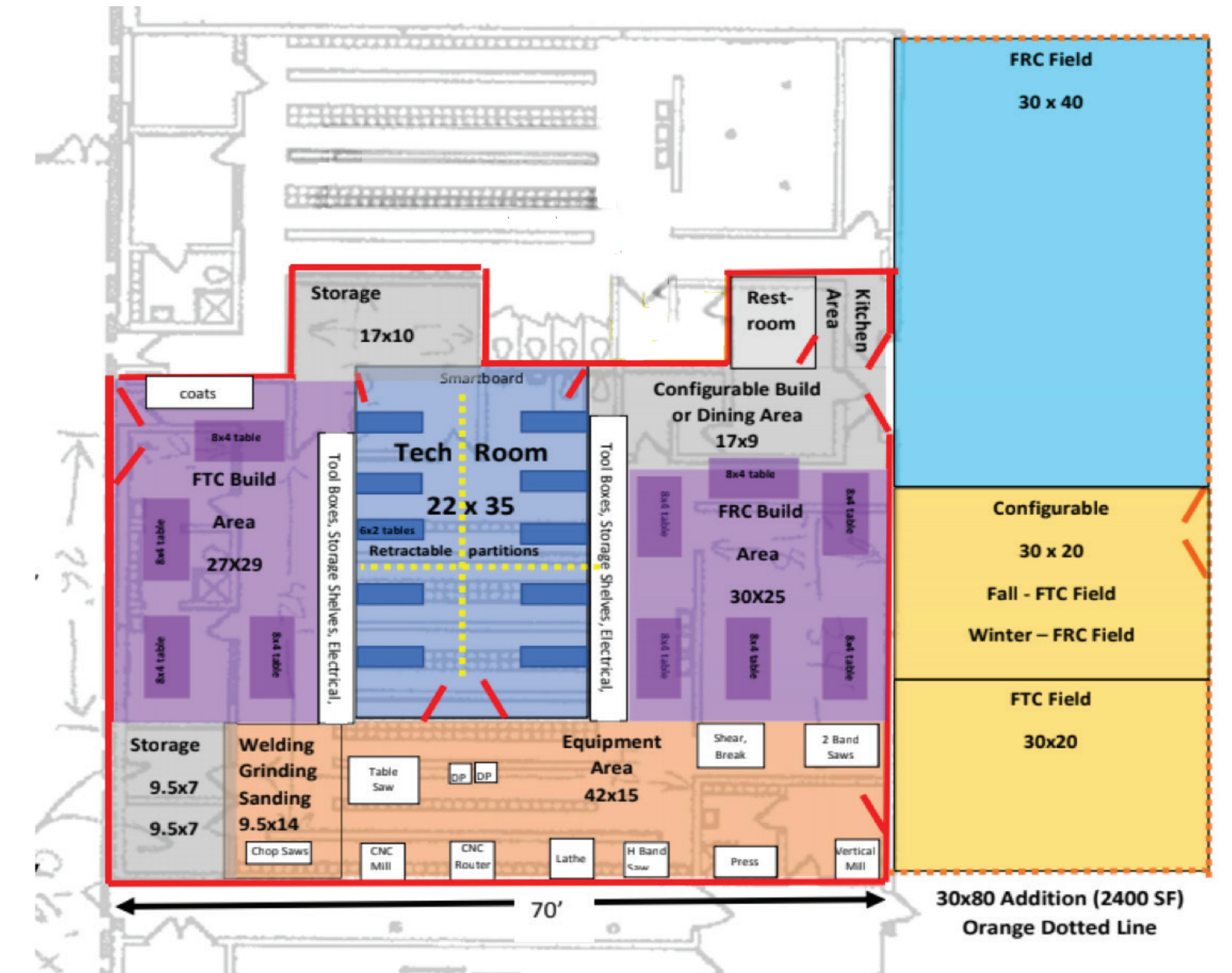
