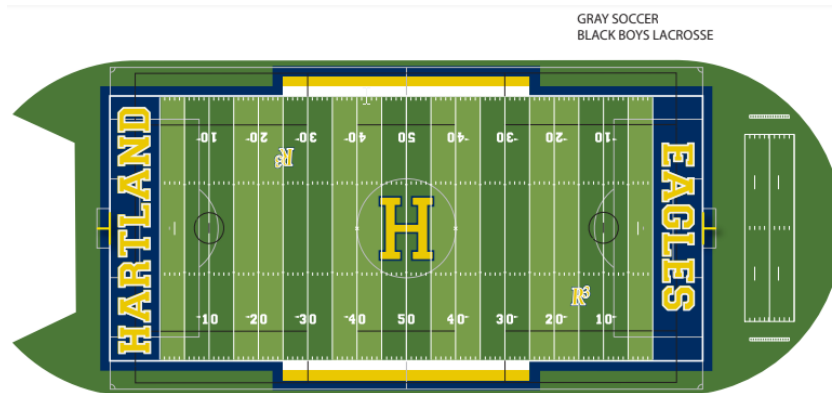

High School Vape Detectors: Unfortunately, the high school has been experiencing issues with vaping in the restrooms and clogged toilets as students dispose of vape cartridges. Due to this continued problem, we have invested in outfitting some restrooms with detectors. I share this with you so that you can talk with your children about the process of addressing alarms that go off during the day. If an alarm goes off indicating unlawful activity, the administration will visit the alarm location and pull video from the cameras outside the restroom around the time of the alarm. Students may be pulled into the office if they are present when the alarms go off. Parents would be contacted if this occurs.
