February Bus Driver Incentive: If you know someone who might be interested in driving a bus for the public schools in Livingston County, please see the limited time offer below. ***Fully Licensed/trained driver** hired to fill a regular route vacancy will receive a \$ 5,000 hiring incentive. \$3,000 will be paid on the first paycheck, the remaining \$2,000 will be paid on the paycheck following 6 months of employment.

***Fully licensed/trained driver that is hired as a substitute and will work at least 20 hours per week:** will receive a \$3,000 hiring incentive. \$2,000 paid on the first paycheck, the remaining \$1,000 will be paid on the paycheck following 6 months of employment.

***Driver that needs licensure and training** will receive a \$2,000 hiring incentive. \$1,000 paid on the first paycheck, the remaining \$1,000 will be paid on the paycheck following 6 months of employment.
