Dear HCS Community:

2023-24 Parent Engagement Workshops: The district has teamed up with all public school districts in Livingston County and the Livingston Sunrise Rotary Club to provide relevant parent engagement workshops for the 2023-24 school year. In Hartland, we have had board members, parents, and staff ask for more parent-focused mental health education opportunities, so this effort seemed to be a good fit for HCS.

Why focus on mental health? The American Academy of Pediatrics has declared a National Emergency in Child and Adolescent Mental Health. Rates of childhood mental health concerns and suicide rose steadily between 2010 and 2020, and by 2018 suicide was the second leading cause of death for youth ages 10-24. The pandemic has intensified this crisis: across the country we have witnessed dramatic increases in Emergency Department visits for all mental health emergencies including suspected suicide attempts. Our students are experiencing these issues and we want to help equip families with trusted research-based resources.

<u>What is ParentGuidance.org?</u> ParentGuidance.org is a free website for parents, or really anyone, to have a trusted place to go when they have questions. Our goal is to empower parents to have a positive impact on their child's mental health, and teach them how to tackle hard topics and situations with their children.
