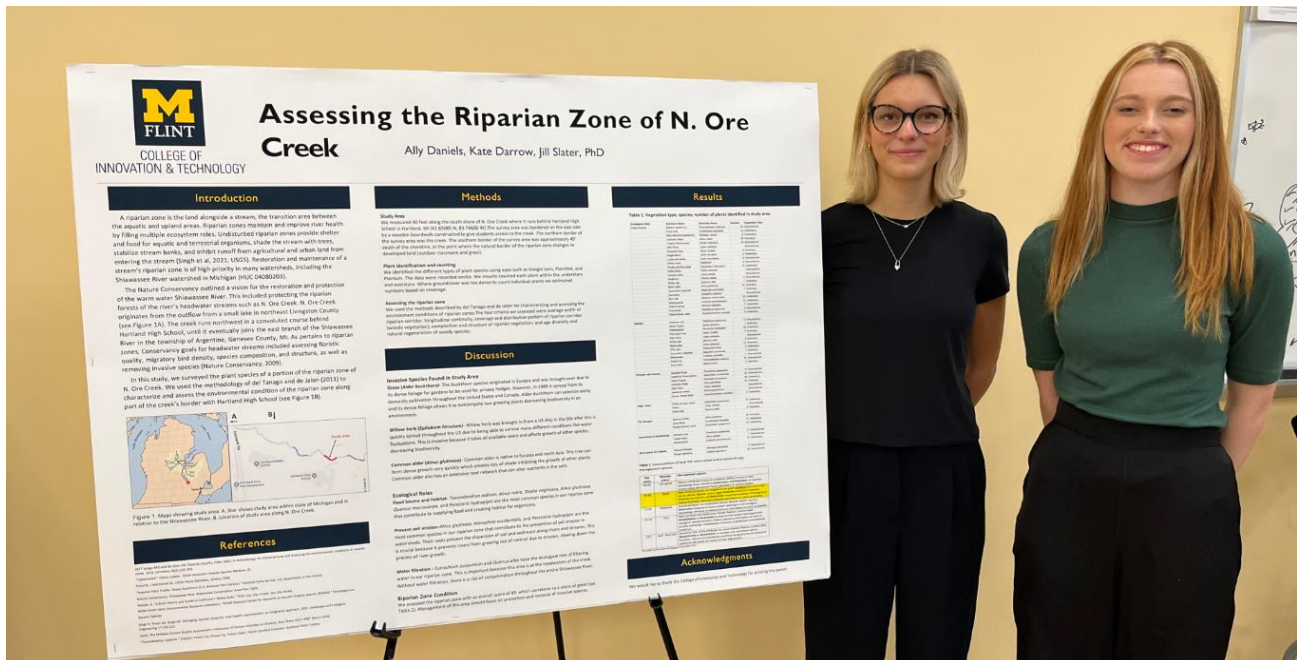
Staff Participates in Bell Ringing: Staff and Board members participated in bell ringing for Salvation Army. Thank you for taking time to do this for a great cause.
