Reminder “What is Bullying”

Earlier in the year I shared information regarding the differences between rude behavior, mean behavior and bullying. None of these actions are appropriate and meeting the standards of reason, respect and responsibility.

Bullying: The intent to do harm, create a power imbalance, or repeated acts of threatening or aggressive behavior is the definition of bullying. Students who continue to intentionally hurt others without regret or remorse are engaging in bullying behavior, which is never acceptable and falls under the districts bullying/harassment policies.

Mean: Mean behavior is done to hurt someone, physically or emotionally. Usually, this type of behavior is associated with anger and is often a regrettable event by the person engaging in this.

Rude: This behavior is not necessarily intended to hurt. Actions like showing off, cutting in line, talking over someone, refusing to share, etc. are rude in nature. These actions are often spontaneous and thoughtless.

I ask that parents review these definitions and impress upon your children that none of these actions are acceptable in any way.
