If you do not have training, NO PROBLEM! We will train you and you will receive a \$2,000 hiring incentive and be paid to train.


Reaching Higher Summer Camp: I have attached a flyer at the end of this letter with an opportunity for students in grades 1-5. If interested, please reach out soon.
