President Dumond called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

5/10/21 AGENDA APPROVED

Motion by Kenrick, supported by Hemeyer that the agenda for the May 10, 2021 regular meeting be approved. Motion carried 7-0.

Motion by Hemeyer, supported by Costa that the minutes of the April 12, 2021 regular meeting be approved. Motion carried 7-0.

SUPERTINTENDENT'S REPORT

BOND UPDATE

Matt Marino gave an update on the bond work. We received 10 new buses and are selling (10) 2011 buses. We received all bids for the robotics center and are currently reviewing them. Matt also reviewed the 2022 projects and noted that all bond work updates can be found on our website.

HCS DIVERSITY, EQUITY, & INCLUSION UPDATE

Superintendent Hughes addressed the concerns within the community about critical race theory and the falsehood that it is being taught in Hartland Schools.

SPECIAL BOARD MEETING MAY 19, 2021

Eileen Jankowski is up for reelection to the LESA Board. We will need to vote at the May 19th Board meeting.

EXTENDED COVID-19 LEARNING PLAN

Superintendent Hughes spoke about questions he has received regarding quarantines. The LCHD supports moving in-class quarantines from 6 feet to 3 feet for contact tracing in the classroom only.

Dave Minsker talked about students that have been identified for summer school. The "Think Stretch" packets for summer work will be delivered to parents the last week of school. He noted the district has tested over 85% of students. Scores look promising going into next year.

Scott VanEpps shared that the average K-12 student attendance 4/12/21 through 5/7/21 was 95.60%.

Superintendent Hughes noted that the Special Board meeting on May 19th has been changed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
